The Adult Learner Award is in honor of Charles Cring, the founder of Harrison College. Established in 1902, Harrison College is committed to upholding the high standards of education that Charles Cring set out to provide to students. Through the Charles Cring Adult Learner Award, we hope to assist those students who are also dedicated to our continued high academic standards.

## ADULT LEARNER AWARD GUIDELINES

In order to be eligible, applicants must be a first-time, full-time student pursuing an Associate of Applied Science Degree. Applicants must have graduated from high school at least one year prior to enrollment at Harrison College (or in the case of a GED, must have anticipated graduation at least one year prior to enrollment at Harrison College). Additional, applicants must meet the following criteria:

### **Step One**

1. Submit an official application.
2. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

### **Step Two**

1. Have expected family contribution (EFC) of 2800 or greater.
2. Submit two (2) personal letters of recommendation.

To qualify for the Charles Cring Adult Learner Award, all materials must be submitted to the Admissions Office no later than one week before the start of each quarter.

Winners for each campus will be selected based on the above qualifications and will be determined locally by the Campus President, a member of the Enrollment Department and various faculty and staff. The decision will be made no later than the Friday before the Quarter start. Awards will be disbursed in \$500 increments over three quarters for a total award of \$1500.
